**LAURA MCCABE'S Embellished Beadweaving!!! ( get on the waiting list!)**

**Bead Dreams 2010 Calendar, \$12.95.** This has gorgeous pix of beadwork that won best of show at B & B in 2008. Also included with the eye candy are artists bio's and inspirations. Nice!!

### From Last Time:

**Beaded Colorways by Beverly Ash Gilbert \$24.99.** This book will teach you to look at your beads as a painter looks at their palette. You will learn to mix your beads and gems to create spectacular jewelry. To assist you in that, you get 2 color wheels included with the book. There are 18 projects along with an in depth discussion on color theory and clear photos with step by step instructions. Very well done! If you are color challenged here is your answer!

**Bugle Bead Bonanza Jamie Cloud Eakin \$21.95.** This has 30 projects that highlight bugle beads. Some of the pieces include Scallop Weave Earrings, Ruffle Bracelet, Victorian Fringed Choker, Double Fringe Pouch and much more. Jamie has created these designs in six color families such as Safari's earthy tones and Seaside's blue and gr\*\*\* hues. The instructions and graphs are very well done as is her last book. 144 pages softcover.

### The Two new Dutch Books are here!

**Netting Sets by Maddy Kuijper, \$12.99.** This one has some gorgeous netted necklaces that use seed beads. You also get matching bracelets patterns for almost all the necklaces. Some earring patterns too! The book is in 3 other languages besides English and has color diagrams. Very much worth it! Great variety! 48 pages

**Beadjewellery by Leane de Graaf, \$12.99.** This one uses a mixture of seed beads and larger beads in the patterns. You get some really nice pendant patterns, bracelets, necklaces and more. Again, very good diagrams that are easy to read. 48 pages

### From Before Last Time:

**More Seed Bead Stitching by Beth Stone \$19.95.** This has LOTS of informative techniques and step by step instructions. It includes increases and decreases in peyote and herringbone, peyote shapes, spirals including Celini, seamless connections, ropes, Russian spirals and more! I just got this in and already had to order more!!! Really chock full! ( even if it is from Kalmbach) ;-)

**More Necklaces Braided on the Kumihimo Disk by Karen DeSousa, \$21.95.** This is her second book on this subject and it's great!! The instructions and diagrams are excellent. It is suitable for beginners and advanced braiders. The projects are gorgeous and she even tells you how to make beaded toggles and finishes for the pieces!!

**Cube Bead Stitching by Virginia Jensen, \$19.95.** Wow! This book is WAY better than I anticipated. You get some very unique variations of Herringbone using cubes. Over 20 great projects (and neat shape such as trees. Stitches include peyote, herringbone, RAW and St. Petersburg chain. GREAT book! \*note\* I guess I am going to break down and get the little cubes!! STAY TUNED!

**Fusion Beading by Rachel Nelson-Smith \$24.95.** This has 18 projects that are really diverse and interesting! This book is bold and inventive with a mixture of seed bead stitches and wirework. Excellent step by step photos and a lot of great inspiration! VERY NICE!!!

**Beaded Opulence by Marcia DeCoster, \$24.95.** Wow!! I love her projects! This is all about Right Angle Weave and has over 20 projects. Really unique and innovative uses for this stitch abound. Hardback 128 pages Excellent!!!!

**Contemporary Copper Jewelry by Sharilyn Miller, \$22.95.** This one has step by step projects for lots of neat wirework projects using copper wire. You get 22 projects from top designers such as Dale Cougar Armstrong, Rachel Nelson-Smith, Richard Salley, Eugenia Chan and Sharilyn Miller. Also included are creative ideas for distressing copper, cold join metalwork, and designing wire components. You get a lot for your money in this 127 page soft cover book. Very good!

**CD: Wire Knitting on a Spool by Sharon Hessoun \$10!** This is the same as the print version, no additional material. The CD version of the book will work on both PC and Mac with Adobe Acrobat Reader. It is as easy to use as a book, with clickable links from the Table of Contents on the side. No scrolling

through it to find what you want! Project images are large and detailed, shown beside the directions for each. This is a great bargain at only \$10.00

**Easy Peyote-Stitch Bracelet Projects by Lillian Todaro, \$10.** This has step by step fully illustrated instructions for a 4MM cube cuff and a Daisy Band bracelet. Charts are in B & White.. easy to understand instructions!

**Japanese Braiding: The Art of Kumihimo by Jacqui Carey, \$21.95.** This was first published in 1997 as the Beginner's guide.. she has revamped it into a great small , spiral bound book that lays flat for ease of use. The step by step pix are great as are her instructions. You get 6 projects and lots of tips and info! Great book!! 96 pages

**Cookbook: Tennessee Hometown Cookbook, \$16.95.** This is not a bead book but I thought I would let you guys know about it in case you are a collector like me. It has some great recipes and little blurbs about different places in our state. Dang it tho, my possum stew recipe didn't make the cut! ( This would make a GREAT Christmas present!)

**Art Jewelry March 2010 \$6.95.** This one has How to Work with an Amazing Alloy, Learn all about Shibuichi, metal clay, turquoise and much more. There is a great article on How to Get the Most out of Taking a Class.

### From Last Time:

**Whispering Wind Vol. 38 #6 #238, \$4.50.** This issue has Loop Necklaces, Ball & Pin Game, Apache Bags, Ft. Berthold Photos, Cheyenne Mocs and more. This great little Native American mag is just chock full of great info and loads of eye candy. I sure do miss being on the Pow Wow circuit.

**Bead Unique Spring 2010 #24 \$6.99.** This issue has over 40 original projects in it with over 10 charming wedding ideas. There is a felted flower necklace, a metal clay vessel (cover), and tons of money saving ideas. One thing you can say about this magazine.. it has variety! You get about any kind of project you can think of, macramé, lampwork, bead weaving, felting, chain maille, clay, PMC, Kumi and much more! **Jill Oxtan Cross Stitch #79 \$13.50.** This one has some wonderful boxes in it... and POSSUMS!!! Hey.... she must have done that for me? You also get patterns for kitties, lilies, ladies and much more. This is a beautifully done magazine with gorgeous patterns!! The 3 D Lilies are exquisite!!

**Belle Armoire Nov/Dec 09 \$7.99.** This issue has Fancy Feathers, Jacket's for All Hallow's Eve, Suzi Click, Dressed up Trench Coats and more. There is a neat article on cuffs. Gorgeous magazine but not a lot of beading.. well, none this time! ;-)

**Beadwork Collector's Edition \$14.99.** Wow.. this one is chock full of goodies. You get 41 favorite jewelry designs, 50+ tips from designers, 48 best product picks and a bonus pull out section with bead stitches. The projects are really something.. just to name a few.. I love the cover piece and there is a wonderful bracelet called the Jewel Box. It has all kinds of different sizes and shapes of beveled rivoli. I also love the X and O bracelets... just a great mag despite the fact it is from \*them\* ! Sorry!! Can't help it! ;-)

**The Beader's Handbook from Bead & Button, \$7.95.** This has over 100 tips and techniques with exclusive designs and advice from leading experts. This little 98 page magazine is a treasure trove of good info! It has lots of basic info on beads, tools and more.. and excellent instructions on stitches. THEN you get some fantastic projects. **Step by Step Wire Spring 09, \$5.99** This issue has a neat flowery spring pendant, tree of life pendant, copper wire article, and macramé. The Wire macramé project is neat.. and the two toned Turkish Knot chain maille bracelet is nice! Good issue!

**Bead Star 2009 \$7.99.** This has 45 projects made with crystals, stones, glass, pearls and more. It also showcases the winning pieces from the Bead Star Contest.. congrats to my friend Val Aharoni for the cover piece!! The projects vary from simple to complicated. Not a lot of seed beading... Great inspiration.

**Step by Step Jewelry Gifts for the Holidays 2008, \$7.99.** This one has fast and festive gifts.. super easy earrings, a special wire section with chain maille, copper coils and more. You also get 8 peyote and brick Hanukkah patterns. If you like to loom.. cute bracelets!

**Beads 2008, \$7.99.** This is the annual ultimate beader's resource book that also has some projects and events in it. You get a great sections on tools, basic techniques and more. Some easy projects such as rosy sunrise earrings, stone sunburst ring, strung pieces and more. Also Features the Big Bead Book which is suppliers listed by item. ( I still have Beads 2006 and 2007 also! )

**Australian Beading Vol. 1 #2, \$8.95.** This one has 116 pages with some sweet, simple projects and articles on beaders and lampworkers. The necklace on the cover is probably my favorite piece... it's really unique. You also get a nice chain maille project and a very pretty crystal necklace pattern. The Cotton Candy Crocheted purses are neat also!

**Creative Jewelry Vol. 6, \$6.99.** This has 50 trendy designs from earrings in minutes to easy bracelets. Lots of super easy stringing projects... instant gratification.
